BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF JUNE 18, 2013

Meeting was called to order at 11:50 a.m. by President, Candy Roper.

Roll Call: Candy Roper, Judy Johnson, Elaine Oxborrow, Bob Kinney, Sieg Goepner, Bob Newman, Gail Spieker. Also present were: Tony Yarbrough, Legislative Chair, and Cindy Craig, Match Chairman.

Secretary Judy Johnson read the minutes of the April 29, 2013 board meeting. **Motion: Gail Spieker, Second Bob Kinney** to approve the April minutes. **Motion Carried.**

The **Recording Secretary**, Judy Johnson, had no report.

The Corresponding Secretary, Gail Spieker, reported that she sent a letter to JoAnn of Carson Canine Adventures inviting her to attend the June 18, 2013 board meeting to discuss promoting obedience in the BKC.

Treasurer: Beginning balance \$23,193.13, ending balance \$22,979.56. The IRS rejected our tax return filed to conform with the new fiscal year created by the recently AKC-approved bylaws. They require additional paperwork and substantial fees to change the club's fiscal year. It was decided to continue filing the tax return as before the bylaws changes.

Show Committee: Final approval of our 2013 shows has been received and the premium list is at MBF. The need for ring stewards was discussed. The club will put a notice in the premium list and the CCCVB ads will be modified to include a plea for volunteers.

Match: Cindy Craig received approval for the July 13 match as well as the match after Best in Show on Saturday evening of our show.

Unfinished Business:

JoAnn of Carson Canine Adventures did not attend the meeting.

The need for a publicity chairman was discussed. We need to do a better promotion of shows and matches. Cindy is working on a match flyer to be posted in veterinary offices and intends to get notices published in the local newspapers as well as Facebook.

New Business:

Motion: Bob Newman, Second Bob Kinney to have Candy purchase the computer program Dragon Naturally speaking to aid her computer work. **Motion Carried.**

There being no further business, **Motion Bob Newman to adjourn.** Meeting adjourned at 12:55 p.m.

AKC NEWS

Per the AKC.org web site, on June 18, Los Angeles was to consider mandatory spay/neuter on second impound plus other breeder restrictions. Read the full story at http://www.akc.org/press_center/article.cfm?article_id=5028. The AKC is mobilizing members to contact the City Council and voice your opinion on this issue. They have a list of City Council members at the end of the article. If you know someone who lives in LA, you might want to let them know about this issue.

Partial text from article:

The Los Angeles City Council will [on June 18] consider modifications to the current mandatory spay/neuter ordinance to require spay/neuter for any licensed dog that is impounded twice, and will remove exemptions in current law for dogs that have earned or are being trained for and are in the process of earning a title in agility, carting, herding, hunting, working, or other title. It will also require anyone who holds a breeding permit to submit to an inspection by the Los Angeles Department of Animal Services. The measure will further require breeders to implant all dogs sold with a microchip, “to maintain the breeder’s identity as well as that of the new owner’s” on the microchip. 


